## \*\*\*TRELETSKY WINS GRAND OPENING EVENT AT FAIR LANES BOLINGBROOK\*\*\*

Andrew Treletsky became the first ABT Chicagoland North Division champion this past weekend by defeating top seeded Larry Helton by a score of 187+19=206 to 155+9=164 at Fair Lanes Bolingbrook. Andrew was seeded third for our stepladder finals after rolling a 627 series including handicap in the semi-finals.

In the first match of the finals Hal Heuer overtook Benwayne Morrison in the 10th frame to eke out a 168-162 victory. Game two saw a close battle all the way but late split trouble spelled the end of the day for Hal Heuer as Andrew Treletsky came away with the win by a 200-188 count. In match three, Larrlyn Williams just couldn't buy a break leaving four splits along the way as she fell to Andrew by a final count of 232-137. That brought Andrew into the championship match against Larry Helton who had rolled a 632 with handicap to grab the top spot. The match was almost dead even after six frames but Andrew struck inth 7th, 8th, and 9th frames to come away with a 206-164 victory and claim the title in our Grand Opening Tournament.

Andrew Treletsky is a 24 year old driver for Engineered Plastics Products Company. He is single and has been bowling off and on for about six years. He started taking his bowling more seriously about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  years ago and currently bowls leagues at Waveland Bowl and Classic Bowl. Andrew has a high game of 256 with a 604 series to his credit. He was using a Blue Hammer which was drilled at Diversey River Bowl. Andrew said that he has been practicing and it has helped his game to improve. Andrew thanked everyone involved with running the tournament. He also thanked Fair Lanes Bolingbrook for hosting our Grand Opening Tournament and all the spectators who stayed to cheer on the finalists. Andrew plans on using his \$800.00 winnings to help pay some bills. He said that the ABT is a fantastic tournament for the average bowler. He has tried bowling in a number of different tournaments but couldn't cash because he couldn't compete with the higher average bowlers. With the ABT's 189 maximum entering average, he doesn't have to anymore.

Tournament notes: Our Grand Opening Tournament can only be described as a rousing success. 73 new members joined a number of members from other divisions to produce a total of 87 entries. The support we saw this weekend leaves no doubt in our minds that the Chicagoland North Division should quickly grow into one of the largest ABT divisions in the country. All of the bowlers we spoke to seemed to like our shirt promotion so much that we have decided to extend it through the next tournament at Fair Lanes Rolling Meadows.

We would like to thank all the people who helped out over the weekend. Their volunteer efforts really kept things moving smoothly. We would also like to thank the entire staff at Fair Lanes Bolingbrook who did all they could to make sure our first tournament was a good one. We had a fair shot which gave each bowler an equal opportunity to compete. Most of all we would like to thank the bowlers who have welcomed the ABT to Chicagoland. You won't be sorry that you did!!!!!
