Sal Buentello Jr. won his first ABT championship by defeating James Dalke by a single pin, 200-199. Sal was top seeded for the stepladder finals after rolling a 656 handicap series in the semi-finals. Because he was top seeded he had the choice of who would start the match. Sal decided that he would finish first hoping to put the pressure on his opponent. The strategy seemed to be working as Sal took a 31 pin lead into the 9th frame, but a split in the 9th and a strike, spare finish in the 10th left the door open for a possible tie if James could strike out in the 10th. James got the first two strikes but a stubborn 7 pin left him one pin short and Sal was able to breathe a sigh of relief.

In match 1 of the stepladder finals Mark Brown defeated Anthony Morales 163-161. In match 2

Mark struck out in the 10th to defeat Frank Tardio 212-189. Mark's run towards the championship match ended in match 3 as he fell to James Dalke 188-154 which set up the showdown between James and the eventual champion Sal Buentello Jr.

Sal is 18 years old and is employed as an electrician. He is single and has been bowling since the age of 5. Sal currently bowls league at Town Hall Bowl in Cicero. He has a high game of 245 with a 702 series to his credit. Sal was using a Columbia Black Knight to win his championship. He had the ball drilled by Dutch Hoffman at Elmar Bowl. Sal said that his parents and cousins have been a big help in developing his game over the years. He thanked Fair Lanes Rolling Meadows and the ABT for making his victory possible. He also thanked his family and friends and all the spectators for their moral support. Sal dedicated his win to his late grandfather, Thomas Morales Sr. and said that his winnings would be used for some Christmas shopping. Sal said that bowling in the ABT was a lot of fun and he got to meet a lot of interesting people. He also said that there was a good shot. It required a few adjustments for him but it was a fair shot that gave everybody an equal chance to compete and in the ABT that's just how we feel it should be.
