Both bowlers stayed clean for the first four frames but Paul was unable to convert the bucket in the fifth frame and Noly spared to take a one pin lead. Paul came roaring back with strikes in the 6th and 7th frames and again in the 9th and 10th. Noly stayed clean but just couldn't keep pace with the strikes and Paul was our new champion by a final count of 221-201. The 193+28=221 was also a personal best for Paul.

Paul Wampach is a 32 year old salesman for Sanco Supplies. He is single and has been bowling off and on for about 6 years. He currently bowls in the Our Lady of Wayside League at Fair Lanes

Rolling Meadows where he carries a 155 average. Paul was using an Ebonite Gyro that he got at Hermann's Sporting Goods. Paul said that fellow ABT member Roy Andersen has helped him with his game but unfortunately Roy wasn't there to see Paul win. Paul thanked Espo's Country Lanes for the fine job they did in hosting our tournament. He also thanked his fellow bowlers and all the spectators who stayed to watch the finals. Paul said that the \$800 he won would be used to pay on the new car he just bought. Paul said that bowling in the ABT is a "ton of fun." All he was really hoping for was to be able to qualify for the semi-finals. He did that and a lot more.
